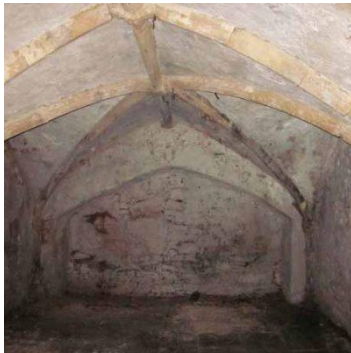

## President's Meeting - Saturday 28 October 2017 Tour of the Old City of Bristol

Our President, Neil Holbrook, invites you on a walking tour of the Old City of Bristol with Bob Jones, former Senior Archaeological Officer for Bristol City Council. This will be a marvellous opportunity to explore the line of the original town walls and discover what lay within their protection. Bob will bring alive the Old City with its pre-Conquest streets, church on the town wall, medieval 'takeaway', houses, taverns and administrative buildings.



We will meet **at 1.30pm** by the concrete 'obelisk' on the east side of High Street, just across Bristol Bridge and almost opposite St Nicholas Church. This marks the entry to a complex of fifteenth-century decorated cellars (illustrated left, currently inaccessible) which were used for the storage and selling of wine. The walk will last two hours.

The afternoon will finish with tea/coffee and cake at St Stephen's Café at a cost of £3 per person. Full details will be sent to those who have booked using the form below.
